MALL AND VICINITY

THEFT FROM & MISCHIEF TO VEHICLE:

Court at King of Prussia, Aisle 1 G: Occurred 12/28/2006 between 1615 and 1700 hours. An unknown person smashed the driver's door window on a 1994 Lexus and removed electronic equipment from within.
