MALL AND VICINITY

THEFT FROM AND MISCHIEF TO VEHICLE;

KING OF PRUSSIA PLAZA, WEST GARAGE AISLE 1 1/2D: Occurred on 04/12/07.

Unknown person(s) smashed driver side window on a Nissan Maxima. Missing from vehicle is a satellite radio head unit and a GPS system.

KING OF PRUSSIA PLAZA, EAST GARAGE , 2F: Occurred on 04/15/07. Unknown person broke out the driver's side window of a Toyota Sienna and took a NAVMAN 5700 GPS system from inside the vehicle.

KING OF PRUSSIA PLAZA PARKING LOT, POLE 41B: Occurred on 04/16/07. Unknown person broke out the driver's side window of a Toyota Rav 4. Missing was a Garman GPS system.

KING OF PRUSSIA PLAZA PARKING LOT, POLE 41B: Occurred on 04/16/07. Unknown person broke into 2002 Toyota Corolla smashing out the front passenger window. Vehicle owner had left her purse on the passenger seat. Inside the purse was her Nextel phone. Both items were stolen.

BALLY'S TOTAL FITNESS PARKING LOT: Occurred on 04/16/07. Victim reports that front passenger window on his 2004 Toyota Rav4 had been broken out. Taken from the front seat of the vehicle was a black duffle bag containing numerous personal items.

BALLY'S TOTAL FITNESS PARKING LOT: Occurred on 04/16/07. Victim reports his front passenger window on his white Ford van was smashed out. Garman GPS along with the charger cable was taken.

UNITED ARTIST IMAX THEATER PARKING LOT: Occurred on 04/16/07. Victim reports his vehicle, a 1995 Ford Thunderbird, was broken into in front of the Imax Theater. He didn't notice the punched lock on the driver's door until he arrived home and had a hard time opening and closing it. Personal items had been stolen from within.

VEHICLE THEFT – 900 BLOCK PENN CIRCLE: Occurred on 4/17/07. A 2005 silver Volkswagen Jetta was taken from the lot during the overnight hours.

AREA EAST OF HENDERSON ROAD

PROWLER – 500 BLOCK “A” STREET: Occurred on 04/17/07 approximately 0130 hrs. Victim reports hearing the outside gate open and someone trying to open the back door. Victim

looked out the window and saw a young, male, with a black knit cap, wearing a black sweatshirt. After trying the door the male walked toward Flint Hill Road.

ARMED ROBBERY – GENUARDI'S PARKING LOT: Occurred on 04/12/07 at 1900 hrs. Victim stated the robbery occurred as he approached his vehicle in the parking lot. A maroon Ford Crown Victoria, with faded paint, pulled up behind him with the passenger side facing his car. The robber, light skinned, male aged late teens to early twenties exited and approached victim. The robber was approximately 6" tall with cornrows in this hair and a mustache/goatee. He was wearing a baggy army green zip up hooded sweatshirt with sequins in the front. Victim stated that he had started to turn around when the robber ordered him not to so. The victim then felt the muzzle of a handgun pressed behind his left ear while the robber patted down the victim's left pants pocket. The robber found cash and stated, "Jackpot." Cash was taken from the victim by the robber who reentered the vehicle while again ordering victim not to turn around. The maroon vehicle fled by turning left onto S. Henderson Road. The maroon vehicle was driven by second male, clean shaven, wearing a black skull cap and black quilted jacket.
