MALL AND VICINITY

THEFT FROM VEHICLE – BAHAMA BREEZE: Occurred 04/16/07. An employee of restaurant states that her vehicle had been broken into while she was working. A laptop computer was missing from the vehicle.

THEFT FROM VEHICLE – BAHAMA BREEZE: Occurred 04/22/07. Missing items include a Garmin GPS unit, a Dell laptop computer, and a Motorola cell phone.

THEFT FROM VEHICLE – COURT GARAGE 2ND LEVEL 2D: Occurred 04/25/07. Missing was the pink slip to the vehicle and items of clothing from the glove box.
