Dear Camp Beechtree Parents,

Welcome to Camp Beechtree 2019! We are ready and excited to meet the campers on Monday, June 24th.

When you arrive on the first day of camp, please park your car and walk your child into the classroom. We will have our sign in/sign out table outside the classroom, you will need to sign in and sign out daily. Once you sign your child in, you will have the opportunity to meet with the camp director and counselors.

Camp runs from 9:00am – 1:00pm each day. **Any camper dropped off before the start time will be unsupervised.** Any camper **picked up late**, will be charged the following **DAILY LATE PICK-UP FEES: \$1.00 PER CHILD, PER MINUTE**. Snacks and lunch should be sent daily, in a sturdy lunch bag, with your child's full name clearly marked on the bag. Camps do not have access to refrigeration or microwaves, so please plan accordingly for your child's lunch needs.

In preparation for camp, please read the important information located below:

- Some important items to bring to camp: book bag, water/juice, snack, water shoes/sandals, towel, change of clothes. All items should be clearly marked with your child's name.
- Please send your child to camp with his/her swimsuit underneath his/her clothing (on water play days) as **counselors are not permitted to change the campers.**
- For several of our arts and craft activities, we will need empty paper towel rolls, toilet paper rolls, and tissue boxes. We would appreciate the donation of any of these items.
- Please leave all personal items such as toys, video games, etc. at home. Staff is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

We will need signed permission slips for the face painting and treat day activities. Please find the forms on our website and return them on the first day of camp to the camp director.
