I hope and trust all is well with you during these unprecedented times. I wanted to take a few moments to reach out and give you an update on our summer plan for operations.

First, we are sensitive to the fact that summer is an important time for kids and that you look to us to provide safe and structured activities. The staff has been working hard to plan all the various camps, programs and events that you have come to expect. We are currently reviewing the various guidelines that have been released from the federal, state and local authorities. The safety of our participants and staff is critical to our operations and is not negotiable. The decision to operate Summer Camps (Adventure Day Camp, Camp Beechtree, Consortium of the Arts and Teen Leadership) will be made by Friday, May 22nd. If we do cancel these programs, full refunds will be given.

In reference to our Community Pool, we do not plan on opening on Memorial Day Weekend. We hope that we will be able to open the pool at some point this summer once restrictions are lifted and proper protocols and guidelines are established in accordance with recommended CDC Standards and PA Dept of Health regulations.

The Upper Merion Parks and Recreation Staff are currently working to provide other alternatives for everyone. Please stay tuned to our website and social media. We will begin sending out updates on new and exciting activities once they are put in place.
