Upper Merion is home to an abundance of incredible small businesses that many in our community have grown to know and enjoy. One such business is the Workhorse Brewing Company which has been located on King Manor Drive since 2018.

The Workhorse Brewing Company started as a distribution hub for Southeastern and Central PA, as well as neighboring counties. The founders of Workhorse Brewery picked Upper Merion for the access to its distribution network. Nate Olewine, Chief Brewmaster and COO, indicated that “working with the township has been good, as they have been helpful with permits and related business needs”.

All of their beers are crafted on-site in the brewery, and sold in cans which are more convenient and do not allow light penetration.

The Workhorse Brewing Company is proud of their work culture, as they have enjoyed limited turnover. The staff is passionate about service and are happy to arrange tours and tastings to enable folks to enjoy the true beer experience. In addition, you may have seen their food truck at the Concert Under the Stars.

The brewery includes an inviting taproom, which accommodates 200-225 patrons, and outside seating. Along with food, the taproom hosts a variety of events including Trivia and live music. They accommodate all drinking tastes, as they sell wine, cider, spirits, and mixed drinks. Catering services are available, along with private event space and opportunities for corporate events.
