The Upper Merion Township Police Department will be conducting a written examination for the position of probationary police officer on Saturday, March 16, 2024. Applications may be downloaded at

Valley Forge Rd., King of Prussia, PA 19406. <u>All applications</u> must be returned by 5:00 PM on Wednesday, March 13, 2024. There is <u>NO FEE</u> to apply for this position. Act 120 certification is <u>NOT</u> a requirement to apply.

<u>TEST LOCATION</u>: Upper Merion Middle School 450 Keebler Road, King of Prussia, PA 19406

<u>TEST TIME:</u> Start time will be determined by the number of test sessions required to accommodate all applicants. After March 11, 2024, check our website at: https://www.umtownship.org/departments/public-safety/police/, under the recruitment tab, for test day information. Applicants arriving for the incorrect session or late for their assigned session will not be admitted. Applicants will not be contacted directly unless there is an issue with their application.

<u>TEST INFORMATION</u>: All applicants must present a photo drivers license and bring two SHARPENED #2 lead pencils. NO weapons, phones, food or drinks will be allowed in the test site.

<u>SELECTION PROCESS</u>: The top 75 written test scores equal to or greater than the median score or 75%, whichever is greater, will be notified to proceed to the physical fitness qualification on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>April 13, 2024</u>. Physical Fitness Standards are available at the PA Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission. <u>Graduation standards of the 30th percentile</u> age & gender adjusted rankings are used for the physical fitness qualification: https://mpoetc.psp.pa.gov/training/Pages/Physical-Fitness.aspx Applicants successfully completing the physical fitness portion will be scheduled for oral interviews.
