Children's Services:

The library offers two separate book discussions programs for kids during the summer. Middle school age students may participate in a five-week Middle School Monday night program that began June 25, 2018. There is also a four-week Literary Lunch Group that meets for lunch, discussion and a trivia competitions on Thursdays.

Twelve middle school age students met with Becky Ginther to discuss, Me and Marvin Gardens by A.S. King on June 28, 2018.

Sue Kirkpatrick provided outreach services to Camp Beechtree on June 25, 2018.

On June 26, 2018, staff members from Montgomery Department of Health and Human Services gave away bike helmets on a first come first serve basis to 75 lucky children, teens and adults.

The library continues to enroll preschoolers in the 1,000 Books before Kindergarten Program.

David Darwin entertained approximately 250 people with his one man juggling comedy show on June 19, 2018. Story time classes for children from birth to 5 years began the week of June 25, 2018.

The library has extended library services to the campers enrolled in the township's Adventure Day Camp and the school district's Extended Day Programs.

Book author, Alex London visited the library on July 2, 2018 as part of tour of libraries in Montgomery County Sponsored by the district.

This year's reading club centers on the theme Libraries Rock and will feature a different theme related display on the small table each week. Meera Alve's display "Just Dewey It" highlighted popular non-fiction books. Weekly displays featured materials about musical instruments, biographies and fictional stories about musicians, and the science of sound. There were separate holiday displays for Juneteenth, Flag Day, Father's Day and the Fourth of July and separate displays on the dogs and summer.
