Adult Services and Director's Comments:

- Winter Reading for Adults and High School students started February 14, 2019.
- Family Game Event on Monday, January 21, 2019 was attended by almost 40 patrons.
- Stress Management Strategy on Wednesday, January 23, 2019 was a huge success.
- Our very first Seminar on Acupuncture was led by Dr. Meredith on Monday, January 28, 2019.
- Coloring Night Group met a few Mondays in January.
- Knit Nite in January was attended by many of our regulars.
- We will be celebrating the 20th Anniversary of our annual Black History Event on Saturday, February 23, 2019.
- The displays in the library featured beautiful designs of Mandala artwork in the case and large post-it type notes in front of the reference office with ideas and motivational words to jump start the New Year. Books offered help in initiating changes in behavior. The outside cases featured calendars from past years with pictures of lighthouses and beautiful scenery.

Children's Services:
