- Upper Merion Township Library was selected to host young Adult book author, Margo Rabb, author
  of <u>Kissing in America</u> on July 6, 2016.
- On July 7, 2016, sixteen middle school students participated in the In My Head Art Workshop led by art educator from the ACPPA Art Center.
- Laura Arnhold led two Sports Science Workshops in July.
- GSK sponsored a free hands-on experiment oriented science classes for 2<sup>nd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> graders during the week of July 11-14, 2016.
