## **NEW MEMBER INTRODUCTION:**

The Environmental Advisory Council welcomed Pepper Francis, 7<sup>th</sup> grade, as the newest member of the council.

## **ONGOING ITEMS:**

Ready For 100 - Next Steps

As the resolution passed 5-0, the council discussed what actions should be taken moving forward. Ultimately, funding must be secured to contribute to an energy planner being hired throughout Montgomery County (per the stipulations of the resolution) which would possibly go through Public Works, or may be secured through a BCA Grant. In addition to funding, public education in regard to how clean energy works and what options are available is necessary in order to gain traction with residents. The target date to launch educational initiatives in this respect would be Earth Day 2020.

## Single-Use Plastics

It was agreed that the best course of action, before any ordinances would be passed, would be to start an awards-based system with local businesses to encourage green practices, like no longer offering plastic bags or straws, and advertising them in the local paper specifically for switching to green practices. The council will work to create a ranking or point system in support of the initiative.

## Styrofoam Use in Upper Merion Area School District

As there is already a student liaison, she will reach out to a teacher or staff member to discuss the possibility of starting a petition to remove Styrofoam lunch trays from the cafeteria, which will hopefully carry over to the high school.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Farmer's Market Dates

### New Ideas for EAC Involvement

It was suggested that there will be a working session to make a plan of action for all of the projects and timeline goals, and from there start working to create sub-committees and student groups which would work on specific projects.

#### Mulch Pile

Concerns have been raised by citizens, members of the EAC, and Daylin Leach's office regarding the proximity and operations of the mulch processing facility to Gulph Elementary School. While the zoning of the location allows for the type of work to be done, there is reason to believe that they are not limiting their activities to the development of mulch and may be using prohibited materials. An independent air study was conducted by the high school last year but environmental factors led to a follow-up study which will be conducted in better conditions to produce more conclusive results. The high school has withheld the results of the initial test in anticipation of a possible lawsuit.

## State-Wide EAC Network

Upper Merion Township has been chosen to host the state-wide EAC Network in May of 2020.

In September at Fairmount Park in Philadelphia, there is a workshop dedicated to different EAC's throughout the area where attendees are eligible to win miniature grants through raffles, as well as share ideas and discuss mutual goals.
