## **EXECUTIVE SECRETARY'S REPORT**

Mr. Kraynik reported on the following:

- 1) Update on Land Development Plans
  - Mr. Kraynik reported that Schultz Enterprises on 541 Flint Hill Road is looking to construct a 40,000 sf, 1-story for recreational use and warehousing. They also want to put in a 116- spaced

paved parking lot. This would result in \$314,000.00 tapping fees for the Authority.

- ▶ Mr. Kraynik advised Brandywine building renovation at 500 N. Gulph Road wants to add an additional 3,000 sf, small office renovations. This would result in \$13,000.00 in tapping fees for the Authority.
- Mr. Kraynik advised that Workhouse Brewer on 250 King Manor Drive will be an 18-room brewery with a tasting room that will result is roughly \$85,000.00 in tapping fees for the Authority.
- ▶ Mr. Kraynik advised that the Village of Valley Forge is continuing to build out and need additional EDUs which will be provided as per agreement. This will result in \$150,000.00 of additional revenue for the Authority.
