WEEKLY BULLETIN

For the week ending on **August 24, 2017**

Upper Merion Police Officers responded to 528 calls for service including 29 automobile crashes, 9 Retail Thefts, 8 domestics, 6 disabled vehicles, 18 meet complainants and 43 alarms. Some notable incidents from the same are detailed below:

MALL AND VICINITY

Theft from Motor Vehicle

Village at Valley Forge North Garage 220 Village Drive – occurred 8/14/17
