Upper Merion Police Officers responded to 512 calls for service including 16 automobile crashes, 13 Retail Thefts, 10 domestics, 6 disabled vehicles, 4 meet complainants and 46 alarms. Some notable incidents from the same are detailed below:

## MALL AND VICINITY
