WEEKLY BULLETIN

For the week ending on **March 30, 2017**

Upper Merion Police Officers responded to 510 calls for service including 30 automobile crashes, 6 Retail Thefts, 5 domestics, 15 disabled vehicles, 7 meet complainants and 53 alarms.

Some notable incidents from the same are detailed below:

MALL AND VICINITY

Damage to Vehicle

Hampton Inn 530 West DeKalb Pike – occurred 3/24/17 between 0900 and 1300 hours

The manager reports intentional damage to her vehicle while parked at location.

Harassment

GNC 230 Village Drive – occurred 3/26/17 at 1715 hours

An employee reports that since 2013, a subject has been coming into the store, often several times on the same day and makes her uncomfortable with his mannerism & peculiar behavior. Police waited in the parking lot and approached the subject who quickly tried to walk back to his vehicle upon seeing the officer. The subject was advised that he is no longer wanted at the store and his return could result in further police action.

Ambulance Request

Parkview Drive and Penn Circle – occurred 3/24/17 at 1525 hours

UMPD and EMS responded for an overdose inside a vehicle with CPR in progress. Officers located the victim who had just injected heroin. Police administered Narcan and the victim regained consciousness.

Drug Arrest

Officers were responding for a noise complainant when they encountered two subjects in a vehicle. In plain view were hypodermic needles and baggies of heroin, which the occupant stated she bought in Pottstown. The female was arrested charged with possession of the control substance and paraphernalia.
