- Upper Merion Township Library was selected to host local book author, Jon McGoran as part of a Teen Author Tour sponsored by Montgomery County Norristown Public Library on July 20, 2020. A group of middle school students met every Monday night in July except for July 6th for a book discussion and book trivia competition using the Kahoot gaming platform.
- BCA grant recipient, Suhas Ganta partnered with the library to offer a four-week session of basic coding classes for middle school grade students that began on July 23, 2020.
