**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER
MERION, MONGOMERY COUNTY, PA
APPROVING COLLECTION PROCEDURES,
APPOINTMENT OF SOLICITOR, INTEREST
ASSESSMENT, CREDIT CARD AND DEBIT CARD
CHARGES, AND FEES AND COSTS TO BE ADDED
TO THE AMOUNT COLLECTED AS PART OF
UNPAID MUNICIPAL CLAIMS FOR DELINQUENT
ACCOUNTS**

- Section 1. Provides a schedule of fees to be added to unpaid municipal claims for the collection of the claim
- Section 2. Provides for reasonable and necessary costs and expenses to be added to the unpaid claims for but not limited to title searches, filing fees and postage.
- Section 3. Provides for the payment of claims by credit or debit cards for a fee.
- Section 4. Provides for the assessment of interest on unpaid claims at a rate of 10% per annum.
- Section 5. Establishes a collection procedure.
- Section 6. Provides for action necessary by Township officials to implement the provisions of the ordinance.
- Section 7. Appoints a solicitor for the collection of unpaid claims
- Section 8. Provides for a repealer
- Section 9. Provides for a severability provision.
- Section 10. Provides for an effective date.
