SOLICITOR'S REPORT

Tredyffrin Interceptor/Force Main (New Sewer Agreement)

Consulting Engineer, Executive Secretary and Solicitor continue to meet with representatives from Tredyffrin Township discussing issues that arose regarding the new sewer agreement and past capital projects.

Tredyffrin Interceptor

Partial payment will be released to B.P. Paterson for work performed on the Tredyffrin Interceptor and the Township will be holding in escrow final payment until the punch list items are complete.

LeBus

LeBus was not in compliance in the 4th Quarter of 2011. LeBus is requesting a multi-month schedule of how to correct the issues at hand (i.e.: oil and grease exceedance, late filings). The Township and EPA are working with LeBus to get this matter resolved.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Tredyffrin

The Engineer referenced a letter from Pa Turnpike, submitted to the Authority in January, on installing a storm basin on the Turnpike. The topic at hand is the where the installation of the storm basin is positioned and how it may intrude on an existing sewer line. The Authority has expressed their concerns about the installation of the sewer line and whether the position of the installation will be lower than the Township's to allow for minor movement. The Engineer is awaiting a response.

On a motion by Mr. Veneziale, seconded by Mr. Smyrk, with all voting "aye", the Authority's Engineer will perform an engineering assessment on separating the Township's flow from Tredyffrin's flow.

EXECUTIVE SECRETARY

Realen / Valley Forge

Communications have begun between the Township and Realen regarding the next payment. This installment will be payment # 3 of 4 for the initial capacity requested by Realen.

Wegman's (Next Door Restaurant)

Plans have been submitted for Wegman's stand-alone restaurant. No additional movement to report.

Target

Target plan is in the land development phase and discussions are ongoing.

WaWa / Chick-Fil-A

WaWa / Chick-Fil-A plans are in the land development phase and discussions are ongoing.

Casino

The Casino's official "Grand Opening" date to the public is March 31, 2012.

Simon Properties (King of Prussia Mall)

Representatives from the Township met with Simon Properties on March 28 regarding their proposal for future development usage. Simon Properties have been in ongoing discussions regarding plans to construct additional stores, and connect the two malls together. Officially, no plans have been submitted.
