Workshop: Review of Residential Map; Final Review of Residential Districts; AR and SM Districts.

The workshop addressed:

- Inclusion of the U-R Districts of Sweetbriar and Rebel Hill into the R-2.
- Changing the Multi-Family District designations of G and HR to MD and HD.
- Creating separate categories for parcels with court-stipulated agreements.
- The SM District's original and current use. Originally designed for restricted manufacturing, the SM district no longer reflects a true industrial use
- The possibility of combing the SM and SM-1 into one district.
- The possibility of combining the AR and AR-1 into one district.
- Dimensional regulations applying to SM, SM-1, AR, and AR-1.
- Regulations that were designed to protect the surrounding residential areas.
