Meeting Minutes: May 22, 2013

Mr. Sincavage motioned for the Minutes' approval. Ms. Camp seconded. Mr. Garzillo, who was unable to attend the May 22 meeting, abstained. A 2-0 vote, in favor, carried.

In his overview Mr. Loeper noted that:

- The Solicitor requested that the Planning Commission also review minor land development plans.
- The applicant received a Special Exception and Variance from the Zoning Hearing Board on April 3 permitting the use and height of the mono-pole.
- The applicant will request various waivers from the Board of Supervisors.

New Cingular Wireless DP 2013-03

541 Flint Hill Rd.

Telecommunications tower (120 ft. tall monopole) and equipment shelter. 6.95 acres, LI (Limited Industrial).

Present: Christopher H. Schubert, Esg., Riley Riper Hollin & Colagreco.

Exton, PA.

Gary K. Lucas, Jr., PE, Advantage Engineers, West Chester, PA.

Proposed:

- A 126'-high mono-pole, communication tower located in the center of Jamison's Auto Salvage Yard.
- A 336 sq. ft., fenced-in shed constructed on a concrete pad will store utilities and equipment.
- No water or sewer hook-ups.
- A 5-year land lease plus the option of four (4) five-year-lease renewals.
- The site will be designed for co-location which, when actualized, would require a Zoning Hearing Board application for the addition of a 10-foot extension.

Group discussion noted that:

- The location's elevation will enhance coverage in the region.
- The merger of AT&T and NCW resulted in the use of two, non-interfering frequencies.
- The upgrade to "4G" would reduce the electromagnetic field to 200x less than standard.
- The new, single pole is sufficient to decommission the applicant's current line.
- No safety hazards were noted.

In response to Ms. Camp's inquiry, Mr. McKee made a motion to approve the plan as presented. Mr. Garzillo seconded and a 4-0 vote, in favor, carried.

Lafayette at Valley Forge Apartments DP 2013-04

967 Penn Circle

Construction of a 3,360 sq. ft. clubhouse adjacent to the existing swimming pool. 26.31-acres, HR High Rise

Present: The applicant was not present.

From Mr. Loeper's presentation:

The Lafayette Apartments, located next to The Towers complex, proposes to provide a one-story, concession-free clubhouse with a handicap access ramp for its tenants in the area where, currently, some patios exist. No changes will be made to the existing parking lot.

An inlet will collect water from the pool area and disperse it into the existing stormwater management system. The plan has been sent to the County for review.

Group discussion noted no concerns.

In response to Ms. Camp's inquiry, Mr. Garzillo made a motion to approve the plan as presented by Mr. Loeper. Ms. Camp seconded and a 4-0 vote, in favor, carried.
