DISCUSSION:

RE: Proposed Settlement of Realen and Hankin Litigation

The purpose of this special business meeting was to hear and discuss the proposal to settle the lengthy litigation involving Upper Merion Township, Realen and the Hankin Partnership.

Mr. Wagenmann and Mr. Boroff gave a recap of the many years of litigation brought by the Hankin Partnership relating to the Valley Forge Golf Course property. After numerous meetings and negotiations among the Township, Realen and the Hankin Partnership, and the urgency to settle this matter avoiding a court date of July 5, 2012 which could prove catastrophic to the Township, the following settlement affecting the Authority was discussed:

• The Authority will waive the 2013 sewer payment and give an allocation of 47,000 gpd (gallons per day) to the Realen project in exchange for the waiving of the right of first refusal for future sewer allocation.

Following a discussion on this matter, on a motion by Mr. Smyrk, seconded by Mr. Ruddy, with all voting "aye", the proposal for settlement by the Authority was approved. None opposed.

ADJOURNMENT:
