ENGINEER'S REPORT

- Mr. Ciottoni advised that the Attorney and the Engineer representing Children's Hospital of Philadelphia contacted him regarding Trout Run's capacity and current flows. Mr. Ciottoni advised that an analysis will be done to determine if additional capacity is needed.
- Roger Phillips and Gannett Fleming presented the Authority with a draft of the Stormwater Study; which included a 10 year land/soil usage data, timing techniques, concentration areas,

flooding/elevations, matrix functionality, hydraulic models and output for the Stormwater Study. The Authority wants to circle back with Gannett Fleming prior to the rollout to the public to discuss the overall message about the study, specific resident comments and details.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT

Mr. Hann advised about the Mancill Mill Road easement and how the Authority name appears. Mr. Hann advised that he had the name corrected to the proper name of the Authority.

Mr. Hann advised that GSK has some concerns with the capacity of Trout Run. Mr. Hann is not in agreeance with what the analysis done by GSK states and usage will be determined at a later date.
