

# UPPER MERION TOWNSHIP POLICE



## WEEKLY BULLETIN

For the week ending on **November 9, 2017**

Upper Merion Police Officers responded to 546 calls for service including 35 automobile crashes, 12 Retail Thefts, 9 domestics, 11 disabled vehicles, 8 meet complainants and 54 alarms. Some notable incidents from the same are detailed below:

### MALL AND VICINITY

#### CCCF

**Primark 160 North Gulph Road – occurred on 10/21/17 and 10/26/17**

A female customer successfully passed counterfeit \$100.00 bills.

### AREA NORTH OF ROUTE 202 AND WEST OF HENDERSON ROAD

#### Criminal Mischief

**100 block of Crossfield Road – occurred 11/7/17 at 0001 hours**

UMPD and the fire department were dispatched for a vehicle fire in the driveway. On arrival they found vehicle that had a window smashed out, the back seat was filled with leaves and set on fire.
