WEEKLY BULLETIN

For the week ending on **November 30, 2017**

Upper Merion Police Officers responded to 591 calls for service including 37 automobile crashes, 10 Retail Thefts, 6 domestics, 19 disabled vehicles, 17 meet complainants and 54 alarms. Some notable incidents from the same are detailed below:

MALL AND VICINITY

CCCF

Lord and Taylor 180 North Gulph Road – occurred 11/25/17 at 1906 hours

A female was apprehended by Lord & Taylor security after passing counterfeit \$100 bills. It was later determined that she made four purchases at Nordstrom and one at Mac Cosmetics, also using counterfeit \$100.00 bills.

Criminal Mischief

Red Lot B4 160 North Gulph Road – occurred 11/24/17 at 1225 hours

The victim reports that she waived a maroon Pontiac Grand Prix into an open parking space. A male and a female exited the Grand Prix and started yelling and spitting at the victim's vehicle. The male then began hitting the victim's vehicle with his belt and buckle, breaking a window and causing dents. A witness to the incident later saw the actor inside the mall and notified police. The male is being charged with criminal mischief.
