

## UMPR's Earth Day Festival and Recycling Event FAQ's

### **FESTIVAL**

**1. Where is the Earth Day Festival?**

Upper Merion Township's Earth Day Festival is located behind the Township Building in the lowest lot and Township Park; 175 W. Valley Forge Rd, King of Prussia, PA 19406. ([google maps](#))

**2. Where should I Park for the Festival?**

Main Parking is located at the field at the corner of Ross Rd. and N. Henderson Rd, King of Prussia, PA 19406. ([google maps](#))

Reserved parking for staff and Handicap accessible parking will be located at the Township Building. (See Parking Map).

**3. Is there cost for Admission?**

No. The Festival is free admission. It is pay as you go per vendor, food and beer.

**4. Can I Bring my Dog?**

YES! In fact, we insist!

Please be sure your dog is leashed at all times. Any signs of aggression could result in being asked to leave the Festival. (Retractable leashes are not permitted).

**5. Where will the Restrooms be located?**

There will be bathrooms located in the Township Building. Enter in from the back doors from the back lot and head straight back, to the left (up the ramp) and continue heading straight. You will pass the Men's restroom on the right and Women's is all the way back around the corner.

**6. Where will the Beer Garden Be?**

The Beer Garden provided by Conshohocken Brewing Co. will be located near the food trucks.

**7. Can I walk around the entire Festival with my beer?**

Beer is permitted throughout the festival but may not go outside the designated perimeter - made up of stanchions and yard signs.

Must be 21 or older with a valid ID to purchase and consume.

**8. Will there be places to sit and eat?**

Yes. There will be tables and chairs available under a tent close to the food trucks as well as picnic tables near the stage/performance area and in the park for you to enjoy your food/beverages.

**9. Will there be music/entertainment?**

Yes! We will have live performances on and beside the stage by Prose from Dover, DeStolfo's Premier Martial Arts, Allyson Roberts, and Upper Merion Dance & Gymnastics. We have plenty of fun entertainment for kids and adults alike including; crafts, a petting zoo, beer garden and much more! (See Schedule of Activities).

**10. Can I bring chairs/ blankets to sit on in the park?**

Sure! You can bring both/either.
