1. Pledge of Allegiance.
2. Approval of February 20th minutes Motion to approve by Chris, second by Sharon
3. Patio Visit – all visited the patio and agreed it was a great place to rent for a party or meeting
4. Staff Report.
 - a. Entrance Sign – tabled discussion for now
 - b. BCA Grant- UMPR and UMSSC – grants submitted. Will find out May 17 UMSSC grant was for computers, scooters and cultural trips
 - c. Lower Level Renovation – 2 issues (floor has been replaced and AV equipment is ready but waiting for locks on doors to be fixed) Waiting for certificate of occupancy from the Township.
 - d. UMT Foundation – providing 10 families with memberships, social worker has just started identifying and interviewing potential families
 - e. Passholder Update
 1. total passholders as of 4/15 = 2151 members inclusive of 430 new members (since 1/1/18)
 2. charter renewal – 60%, which is what we expected
 - f. Backlighting of sign – for sign above entrance: to consider cascading lights like in Spin studio (don't know cost yet) or backlighting each letter with full range of color and photosensitive (\$7500). Not in current budget
 - g. Corporate outreach - Gerri working on this. GeoBlue came for a tour as did UGI. Also relationship with UMASD (12 members already) Doing a fair at GeoBlue on Thursday
 - h. Joint Meeting 5/10 - reviewed slide presentation, Glennanne and Sudha to fill in with PHOTOS!!!

- i. Roof- BOS approved Hal Lichtman can develop an RFP and bid the project
5. Board of Supervisors Liaison Report – nothing additional to report
6. Park and Recreation Advisory Board Liaison Report –
 - Rotary club sponsoring 80 trees at Bob White Park on Earth Day. Volunteers needed.
 - Crow Creek trail design – will stretch from Walker Park to UMCC
 - 7 playground renovations for this year approved
 - Community garden – land has been leveled. There is a lottery for plots (60 available)
7. Senior Center Representative Liaison Report
 - Trying to get some of the existing programs from morning to afternoon to alleviate the parking issues in the morning
 - Back door buzzer will cost \$1600, which is currently not in the budget. The Board of Supervisors will have to approve
