- 1) Attendance Chris Levy, Sharon Davis, Deena Newman, Terry Stevens, Karen Huller, GlennAnne Chabala, Ben Eyer
- 2) Pledge of Allegiance
- 3) Approval of September 17th minutes Motion by Deena/Second by Sharon Approved
- 4) Staff Report
 - a. Personnel update
 - i. Sudha is leaving
 - 1. Opportunity with City of Philadelphia
 - 2. November 1st is last day
 - ii. Still have not replaced other staff members
 - 1. 2 more interview for custodial maintenance
 - a. Bring in top 4 for additional interview
 - b. Narrow down to one
 - 2. Thursday 6 interviews for financial position
 - 3. One programmer
 - b. Passholder Update
 - i. 664 new members YTD
 - ii. 4 new passholders in last month
 - iii. 2619 passholders (includes silver & fit)
 - 1. GlennAnne is making revisions to reports
 - 2. Will see differences in the numbers
 - iv. \$363,664 in revenue
 - 1. \$40K more than last month
 - 2. All revenue goes to the township general fund
 - c. Pool feasibility
 - i. Bid came in higher
 - 1. Hal gave the original estimate
 - 2. Sharon why was it so much higher
 - 3. No conclusion
 - ii. Dan met with Nick (Finance) and Tony (Township Manager)
 - 1. Will recommend to board to carry \$21,600 into next year's budget
 - 2. Another \$32K to make up the difference

- 3. The aquatics firm, Counsilman-Hunsaker, sold Nick and Tony on going forward
- 4. Paid Hal \$3,400
- iii. GlennAnne will contact MKSD
- iv. The C3AB board responsibilities are done
- v. Things that are currently in need of attention and will be part of feasibility study
 - 1. Pump house is in disrepair
 - 2. Pools need repainting
- d. Winter program preview Thursday December 5th
- e. Holiday village is December 7th at the Township Building starting from 12-3 PM
- f. Budget
 - i. Department heads, Finance Director, and Township Manager review departmental budgets
 - 1. Board sees what department recommended and what manager recommended
 - 2. They will weigh in
 - ii. Cuts
 - 1. Approved- \$1,500 for security camera
 - 2. Approved \$25,000 child watch renovations (estimate was \$1,700)
 - a. Does allow for a teen lounge
 - b. Can use P&R equipment budget for supplies
 - 3. \$56,800 total for feasibility study
 - 4. Nothing else was approved
 - a. Rock Wall
 - i. May still maneuver money in rec supplies for a rock wall
 - ii. We can put in BCA grant for it, but let's see if we can get it in the budget
 - b. Sign backlighting
 - i. Big pushback on this
 - ii. Sharon would like to ask Greg next month why
 - 5. LED sign (which will wait until corner house plans solidify)
 - 6. Dan requested \$2M capital budget, \$185K approved
 - a. Center was not hit the hardest
 - b. \$90K of that is for the center
 - 7. Sharon would like to know for residents' sake why there were such cuts, what other things were more important
 - 8. We still don't cover our own costs
 - iii. Public meeting October 24th
- g. Teen liaison
 - i. Will help us what kind of programming, equipment, and events will attract more teen passholders
 - ii. E-sports
 - iii. More than the basketball demographic
 - iv. Ben is a Junior
- 5) Board of Supervisors Liaison Report
 - a. Greg not in attendance
- 6) Park and Recreation Advisory Board Liaison Report
 - a. Deena was not present, shared notes
 - b. Grant applications through P&R board
 - i. Various sports organizations present their case

- ii. Deena will provide notes

 - i. May not be Mullen tract
 - ii. Catalyst wants to have a big sign up there
 - iii. Proposing moving a library there
 - 1. Is not imminent
 - 2. Some feel location problematic

 - 1. Merrill C Young park
 - 2. Dog park rules proposed
- f. Bat houses
 - i. Dan will order more
 - ii. One is at the township building near the skate park
 - iii. Other one is at Heuser
 - iv. It can take a couple years for bats to nest
 - v. Jeff will keep watching
- g. Fields and township use with shortage
 - i. Caley rebuild lost fields
- h. ECDC subcommittee met for the 1st time
- 7) Senior Center Representative Liaison Report
 - a. Mural
 - i. Perhaps BCA grant application
 - ii. Millie Becker -
 - 1. Asked her if it was possible if someone comes in to set up paint by number to let citizens do the painting
 - 2. Was done in Philly
 - b. Trip to Hagley Museum (Delaware, DuPonts)
 - i. Would the center want it opened up to others besides seniors?
 - 1. Some trips are carpool, some are bused
 - 2. They may not have the numbers they need
 - 3. All day trip, 3 or 4 buildings
 - 4. Trip is this week
 - a. Not enough time to open it up
 - b. Needs advanced notice to add it to community pass
 - c. Open trips are not subsidized
 - d. Department works so far ahead, would need to advertise and open registration for all simultaneously
 - 5. In the future, anything bused can be opened up to general citizens
 - 6. Cannot advertise competing trips
 - 7. GlennAnne will let Terry know when the next opportunity to include senior center trips is
 - ii. GlennAnne saw that some trips are restricted to one guest per member
- 8) Old Business
 - a. Fall Fest was October 5th
 - i. Great weather, great attendance
 - ii. 700 pumpkins
 - b. Foundation visits
 - i. Could be on November workshop meeting

 - 1. \$8,495

 - 3. \$1K shipping and handling
 - 4. \$10,294 for one system
 - 5. Rec supplies budget is \$100K and has to go quite far
 - iii. Deena will find the quote

 - i. Sharon and Paul will go
 - ii. We were invited a year ago, then events occurred
 - iii. We can plan to attend a counsel meeting now
 - iv. Let them know they are encouraged to participate in all rec programs
