## 4. Board of Supervisor's Liaison Report-Tina Garzillo

- 2 town halls at the township building on Tues June 16<sup>th</sup> and July 8<sup>th</sup>. Productive meetings in which the demonstrators expressed their requests.
- Youth engagement event this past Sunday to get youths to register to vote. Several
  officials there.
- Butterfly garden has become a social justice garden. There will be some yoga and meditation and some guest speakers. July 23<sup>rd</sup> from 6pm-8pm. This is being spirited by the MLK committee.
- Will start to have thermal scanners for public who want to attend BOS meetings.
- More cases are on the rise of COVID-19 in the township and county.

## 5. Park and Recreation Director's Report- Dan Russell

- Staff is busy working on a community center health and wellness reopening plan. It has been sent off to be reviewed by the township manager.
  - o Many guidelines for staff and public to follow.
  - o Making adjustments to meet CDC guidelines.
  - o Opening date will be posted once approval is met and a comprehensive plan is completed to reduce any confusion.
- Roof is in place. Currently working on storm water management to divert water away from the building and still need gutters (August).
- ADC in the Park is going well, despite lower attendance. Residents seem pleased.
- In the fall and winter, we are looking at potential uses of the schools for programing.

  Dan is setting up a meeting with the school district to review health and safety plans for this to express how we will be meeting guidelines.
- Looking at a series of budget adjustment and redid revenue projections to 1 million dollars less.
  - o Difficult to plan for next year because we don't know what next year will hold.
