3. Park & Recreation Staff Report – Dillon Muthersbagh
  - Pass holder Update
    - 2307 active members vs 2289 in April
    - Daily visits 281 on weekdays vs 289 in March. 153 on weekends vs 195 in March
  - There are two new families for the Free Passholder Program – Four families were registered in November. Two have expired. We have two new families.
  - Cardio lease was approved at past Board of Supervisors Meeting. New cardio equipment to deliver May 31<sup>st</sup>.
  - Resurface basketball courts the week after Memorial Day. Try to do both at the same time.
  - Senior Center patio work – Contract approved.
  - Pool registration -2428, not many more spots available. 5/20 open house for all to check out the facility. Weight list -258 for non-residents.
  - Limiting members to 2 guests per visit. 2500 capacity visit.
  - BCA Grant awards have been announced
    - Upper Merion Parks and Recreation (Consortium of the Arts Graphic Art) - \$1500 – for tablets to enhance the art/design programs at camp
    - Upper Merion Parks and Recreation (Teen Sports Leadership Academy) - \$2500 – training materials, equipment, and supplies for Flag Football and Youth Basketball Teen Leadership Program
    - Upper Merion Township Pool (Programming) - \$1000 – equipment for new Splash Ball programming at the Pool
    - Upper Merion Township Pool (Learn to Swim) - \$1000 – equipment for Learn to Swim programming... fins, kickboards, floats, etc.
