4. 3. Park & Recreation Staff Report – Dennis
 - Pass holder Update
 - 2305 active members in March vs 2296 in February.
 - Daily visits 322 on weekdays vs 332 in March vs 157 weekends vs 220 in February.
 - Free Passholder Program. Families regularly visiting. Two memberships are expiring at the end of April. 19th. There are 5 or 6 on the waiting list. Will evaluate for next steps. Schedule new interviews. Handful of applicants.
 - Curlbar – new and in good use in gym.
 - Hired a new maintenance person.
 - Hosting Senior games – Pickleball Senior games. Monday May 6th. Men's and Women's 60 and older.
 - Pool – open on May 25th. Open house Sat 1-3. 1900 members, 240 non-resident on waitlist. 2750 max capacity
 - Feedback from survey was very good 750 people responded – child watch needs highlighted
 - Walking traffic issues
 - Kids fooling around with no supervision
 - Pickleball not being welcoming – comments
 - 100 people interested but have not tried yet – look to offer a beginner course
 - Interest in outdoor/tennis courts.
 - Good feedback – very satisfied with facility
 - BCA application for child programming at prime hours of the day
 - Reminder 4/20 earth day – township park. – food trucks, beer garden, earth day ceremony sustainable vendors – 11-2 at Township building.
