## ABOUT YOUR STEIN

All Westerwald pottery is signed, dated and stamped with a potter's mark. Your stoneware has passed through the hands of up to eight craftsmen. Because of this, no two pieces are alike.

The seven-inch stoneware vertical stein is a hand-stamped stoneware inscribed with Upper Merion Township, establishment date, and traditional colonial style decoration (leaf embellishment).

Our glazes are lead free and dishwasher and microwave safe. For use in the oven, spray your stoneware with cooking spray and place it in the oven. Heat the oven to 400 degrees for 10 minutes, then turn it off. Leave your stoneware in the oven until it is fully cooled. Your item is now tempered and can be used in the oven. Always allow the pottery to heat with the oven – do not preheat. Please do not place over a direct flame, or place in the freezer.

## HOW TO GET YOUR STEIN

Steins may be purchased individually at the cashier window at the Upper Merion Township Building, at the Upper Merion Foundation's table at all township-wide events, and at the Upper Merion Farmers Market on select Saturdays. Cash, credit, or check (written to "Upper Merion Township") accepted.
