## How to Draw a Plot Plan

- 1. Draw Shape of Lot: Include length of all property lines.
- 2. Draw House on Lot: Include dimensions of house (length & width) Include distance of house from property lines.
- 3. Draw all other buildings or structures on lot: Include Pool, Shed, Sunroom, detached Garage, etc. with distance from property lines noted for each.
- 4. Draw all driveways, walkways and parking areas: Include dimensions and distance from property lines.
- 5. Note location and names of Streets abutting property.
- 6. Include any easements, flood plains, stormwater facilities such as ponds, swales, etc.

## Impervious Surface Breakdown Instructions

- 1. Fill in Address information
- 2. Note Size of lot. Lot size can be found:
  - a. on Montgomery County Tax Assessors website:
    - http://propertyrecords.montcopa.org/Main/Home.aspx
  - b. County tax parcel map at UM Twp. Bldg.
- 3. Note square footage(footprint) of existing house.
- 4. Note square footage of all current walkways, patios, driveways.
- 5. Note square footage of all sheds, detached garages, any other accessory structures currently on lot.
- 6. Add up (Total) all of above.(Total Existing Impervious Surface)
- 7. Note any new impervious surface that you are creating with this permit application

e.g. <u>new</u> house, <u>new</u> driveway, <u>new</u> walkway, <u>new</u> patio, <u>new</u> shed, <u>new</u> garage, etc.

8. Add up (Total) existing and proposed (new) impervious surface

A STORMWATER, GRADING AND EROSION CONTROL PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR CREATING ANY NEW IMPERVIOUS SURFACE ON YOUR LOT BY BUILDING SOMETHING ON LAND THAT IS CURRENTLY GRASS OR DIRT.
