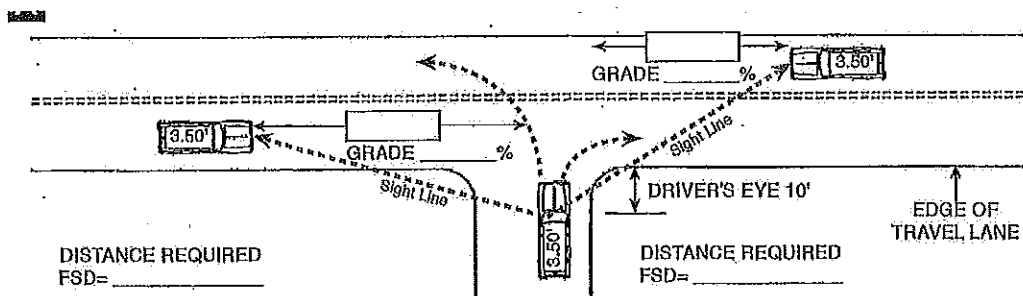
## FENCE SIGHT LINE REQUIREMENTS

To whom it may concern,

Please see the driveway sight distance measurement chart below when erecting a fence or other obstruction on your property. The below measurements are in feet and are only a general guide for you to follow. They are in accordance with PennDOT standards. The corresponding speed limit will change the sight distance accordingly. The distance will only be slightly higher when the vehicle is travelling downhill and slightly lower when travelling uphill.

Sight distance is the distance along a roadway throughout which an object of specified height is continuously visible to the driver. The available sight distance on a roadway should be sufficiently long enough to enable a vehicle traveling at or near the speed limit to stop before reaching a stationary object in its path. The criteria for measuring sight distance should be from the height of the driver's eye above the road surface.
